The jail population report for April was available; the average daily population was 182 and there have been no early releases in 2019.

### VI. Emergency Management report

The Emergency Management Report was available.

Craig Tanis highlighted a few recent activities and also highlighted some upcoming training sessions. He also stated that eight (8) county public school's systems have received school safety grant funding.

A partial activation of the Emergency Operations Center was initiated on May 1<sup>st</sup> to assist the City of Adrian with a barricaded gunman. This was the first time the EOC was activated under the new agreement with the City of Adrian.

Commissioner Bolton questioned road flooding conditions and the committee was informed that local authorities typically monitor the conditions in their immediate area. If assistance is needed by the County Emergency Manager, the local municipality will request that assistance.

The Medical Examiner's report was available as well as a copy of a letter from Hillsdale County Board of Commissioners thanking Dr. Cassin for the excellent and informative annual report. The Hillsdale County Chair is pleased with the joint efforts between Lenawee and Hillsdale Counties.
