I. Approval of Minutes

Motion by Bolton, seconded by Lapham, to approve the minutes of the September 6, 2018 meeting. Motion carried.

II. Finance Reports

Deputy Administrator Kim Murphy reviewed the finance report.

The balance of the MDOC Inmate Housing project has been transferred to the Capital Fund, Building & Site division.

Although the Jail Building Debt fund continues to have a negative balance, that number has been decreasing we will continue to monitor it.

III. Sheriff's report

The Sheriff's report was available for review.

The jail population report for September was available; there have been no early releases in 2018.

IV. Prosecuting Attorney's report

The Prosecuting Attorney's report for September was available for review; PA Castleberry noted that September is typically a very busy month.

There was discussion regarding Resisting & Obstructing charges and liabilities.

PA Castleberry explained that Lenawee County has a consortium that monitors for early intervention and provides training opportunities; he added that body cams are being utilized as well.

Undersheriff Bevier added that new guardian tracking software has been implemented that tracks all sorts of incidents, including positive performance reports.

Deputy Administrator Murphy confirmed that the county has taken proactive steps and there have been no recent incidents of concern.

V. Public Defender's report

The Public Defender report was available and John Glaser noted that the department has been implementing all state requirements and will begin attending all arraignments next week.

VI. Emergency Management report

The Emergency Management Report was available. Craig Tanis noted that there was a National Test of the Emergency Broadcasting system yesterday; the recent exercise at the Judicial Building went well; and he recently completed entering data into the state MIOC (Michigan Intelligence Operations Center) system for MIS events, County Fair, and the Clinton Fall festival.

VII. Medical Examiner report

The Medical Examiner's report for September was available; Dr. Cassin again noted that both death and autopsy numbers are up.

IX. Other Business

Kim reviewed the status of the demolition of sheriff's building.
