

NOTICE OF LETTING DRAIN CONTRACT

KINGSLEY & SUSSEX DRAIN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that I, Jennifer L. Escott, Lenawee County Drain Commissioner, will receive construction bids on **Tuesday, September 17, 2019 at the Lenawee County Drain Commissioner's Office, located at 320 Springbrook Ave., Suite #102, Adrian, Michigan, 49221, until 10:00 a.m.** Bids will then be opened and publicly announced for the construction of a certain drain known and designated as the "Kingsley & Sussex Drain." Bids must be delivered to 320 Springbrook Ave #102, Adrian, Michigan within the timeframes listed above in accordance with the Bidding Documents.

The Drain project consists of the installation of enclosed storm sewer, and drainage structures. Construction and installation of said Drain is described as follows in three sections, each section having the length and average depth as set forth:

Enclosed main branch storm drain construction, cuts of 3 to 9 feet, average depth of cut being 6 feet, beginning at Station No. 2+74 and extending to Station No. 9+76.

Enclosed branch 1A storm drain construction, cuts of 1 to 3 feet, average depth of cut being 3 feet, beginning at Station No. 7+42 and extending south 49 feet.

Enclosed branch 1B storm drain construction, cuts of 1 to 3 feet, average depth of cut being 3 feet, beginning at Station No. 7+42 and extending north 38 feet.

All stations are 100 feet apart.

In the construction, maintenance and improvement of said Drain, the project consists of furnishing all supplies and installation and construction of the following quantities for major items of work and character of tile or pipe, with appurtenances, and the contract let for the same. The following quantities are approximate and final payment will be made on measured quantities:

Install 87 LF of 12-inch Dual Wall Perforated HDPE Storm Sewer. Install 208 LF of 15-inch Dual Wall Perforated HDPE Storm Sewer. Install 222 LF of 18-inch Dual Wall Perforated HDPE Storm Sewer. Install 175 LF of 24-inch Dual Wall Perforated HDPE Storm Sewer. Install 42 LF of 12-inch C76 IV Storm Sewer. Install 73 LF of 24-inch C76 V Storm Sewer. Install two 2-foot Dia. Catch Basins with 2-foot sump. Install three 5-foot Dia. Catch Basins with 2-foot sump. Install two 24-inch Dia. Nyoplast Drainage Basins. Install one 30-inch Dia. Nyoplast Drainage Basin with 2-foot sump. Install 135 LF of 6-inch Schedule 40 PVC Sump Lead. Includes all tree removal, clearing, grading, driveway restoration, HMA roadway restoration, lawn restoration, riprap, end sections, soil erosion measures and all other storm sewer construction related appurtenances.

There will be no (0) bridges as part of the project.

There is one contract being let for all construction, which will include all material necessary to perform the work. This contract will be let in accordance with the Contract Documents now on file in the office of the Lenawee County Drain Commissioner and available to interested parties. Bid will be made and received in accordance with these documents.

Complete Bidding Documents may only be obtained after Wednesday, August 21, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. local time, at the office of Eng., Inc., the Project Engineer, at 4063 Grand Oak Drive, Suite A109, Lansing, Michigan, 48911, upon payment of a \$30.00 non-refundable deposit. An additional non-refundable charge of \$10.00 will be required for sending out Bidding Documents. Checks should be made payable to Eng., Inc.


A pre-bid conference will be held on Wednesday, September 11, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. local time at the Lenawee County Drain Commissioner's Office, 320 Springbrook Ave., Suite #102, Adrian, Michigan, 49221. Representatives of the Lenawee County Drain Commissioner and Engineer will be present to discuss the contract. Prospective Bidders are not required to attend and participate in the pre-bid conference but it is highly recommended. The Engineer will transmit to all prospective Bidders of record such Addenda as the Engineer considers necessary in response to questions. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective.

This Contract will be let in accordance with the Contract Documents now on file in the Office of the Lenawee County Drain Commissioner and available to interested parties. Bids will be made and received in accordance with these documents. Contract will be made with the lowest responsible Bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work. I reserve the right to reject any and all Base Bids to let the Contract based on a combination of both or just the Base Bid, and to adjourn such bid letting to such time and place as I shall publicly announce.

Any responsible person wanting to bid on the above-mentioned work will be required to deposit bid security in the amount specified in the bidding documents (5%) as a guarantee that they will enter into a contract and furnish the required bonds as prescribed by the contract specifications and applicable law.

The date for the Substantial Completion of such contract is 60 Calendar Days, with the date for the Final Completion being 100 Calendar Days, upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed for the Contract. The terms of payment are contained in the contract specifications. The payments for the above-mentioned work will be required to deposit bid security in the amount specified in the bidding documents as a guarantee that they will enter into a contract and furnish the required bonds as prescribed by the contract specifications and applicable law. All bids shall remain open for ninety (90) days after the day of the bid opening, but I reserve the right at my sole discretion to release any bid and bid security before that date.
