Comm. Collins asked for a moment of silence to remember Dr. Cassin who passed away on July 6th.

I. Approval of Minutes

Motion by Van Doren, seconded by Collins, to approve the minutes of the June 1, 2023 meeting. Motion carried

II. Finance Reports: The finance reports were available. The report reflects year-to-date activities. There have been \$31,335 in revenue and \$25,559 in expenses. The current cash balance is approximately \$35,000.

III. Sheriff's Reports: The Sheriff's report was available. Captain Pifer provided highlights on recent events.

A. VESTA Request: The E911 Board has approved the purchase of an on-site controller to be housed on the premises. This will provide a controller that serves only Lenawee County and will be on-site.

Motion by Van Doren, seconded by Krasny, to recommend approving the purchase of an on-site controller, along with entering into a 5-year (24/7/36) Service Contract agreement and 5-year software/hardware refresh at a cost of \$295,249.11 out of the 911 Service fund 261.325.850 Communications. Motion carried.

IV. Prosecuting Attorney's Report: The Prosecuting Attorney's report was available and A. Arnold reviewed several new diversion programs in the Economic Crimes Division including Domestic Violence Diversion, Defensive Driving Diversion, Second Chance Diversion, and Truancy programs.

She also explained office space restrictions and personnel concerns.

V. Public Defender's Report: The Public Defender's report was unavailable.

VI. Emergency Management's Report: The Emergency Management report was available.

VII. Medical Examiner: The Medical Examiner's report was available. K. Murphy reported that Lenawee County has entered into an agreement with Dr. Maino and is continuing to review a proposed regional medical examiner's office.

Dr. Cassin was committed to his profession and he served Lenawee County well.

VIII. Courts: There were no updates from the courts.

IX. Maurice Spear Campus: S. Elliott provided highlights of activities at MSC and concerns regarding detention.

X. Updates & Other Business: There were no updates or other business.
