**II. Department Highlights:** The Health Department reported that environmental health construction is on pace, all clinics are back up and running. COVID walk-in clinics are being held 3 times per week with increased traffic as COVID cases are rising. The County currently has a 16% positivity rate. The Avian Influenza is also being monitored closely with no human positive cases in Lenawee County. The Health Department will be starting back to school clinics to increase regular prevention vaccines that have fallen behind due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Health Department currently has positions for hire in the areas of; Finance Director, Case Management, and Sanitation.

**II. Plan Objectives:** Employees are more healthy and active as shown in the annual Blue Cross Blue Shield health check-up and personal assessment. The County's budget reflects declining insurance rates. Further, anonymous county data shows a decline in major employee health problems.
