Kim Murphy from the Administrator's office presented the financial report which was placed on record.

Mike Sexton from the Maintenance Office presented a parks report.

Mr. Sexton also reported that a meeting is scheduled with representatives of ITC at Gerber Park on June 20th at 3:30 pm to discuss the completion of their construction project.

The Commission then proceeded to a review and discussion of the updated Park and Recreation Plan for the County.

To this regard, commission discussed the possibility of including in the new long range plan, the development of a barrier-free picnic area for senior citizens and disabled persons on the County's small parcel on the west side of Sand Creek Highway adjacent to the airport. This would enhance the opportunity for state grants and matching funds.

The commission also discussed the work with Siena Heights University concerning cross-country meets at Bicentennial Park and the possibility of further work with Clinton High School and the intermediate school district concerning field trips at Taylor Road Park.

The commission also favorably noted and appreciated the ongoing relationship with Jim Hazleman and the US Fish and Wildlife Service.

The next meeting of the Parks Commission shall be on July 15, 2019 at 11:00am.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:05 P.M.
