NOTICE OF MEETING OF BOARD OF DETERMINATION

Notice Is Hereby Given to you as a person liable for an assessment that the Board of Determination, composed of Fayette Miller, Ken Mitchell, Dan VanValkenburg, or alternate will meet **on Monday, April 18th, 2016, at 11:00 o'clock in the morning at the Medina Township Hall, 13450 Lime Creek Road, Morenci, MI, 49256**, to hear all interested persons and evidence and to determine whether the drain known as the Bailey Tile Drain (ME) is necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare, and whether said maintenance and improvement is necessary for the protection of the public health in the following municipalities: Medina Township, pursuant to Chapter 8 of Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended.

Your petitioners further show that the said drain needs cleaning out, relocating, widening, enlarging, deepening, straightening, tiling and/or extending commencing at a point in the Bailey Tile West Branch Drain in Section 20, located approximately at Station 64 according to the survey dated May 29, 1924, thence proceeding across Section 20, through Munson Highway, across Section 19, Highway, also Branch No.1 commencing near Station 31 of the main drain, across Section 19, through Ridgeville Road, and across Section 30, also branch No.2 commencing near Station 16 of Branch No. 1 thence across Section 19, also Branch No. 3 commencing near Station 16 of Branch No. 2 thence proceeding across Section 19, through Ridgeville road and across Section 30 to terminus according to surveys on record at the Office of the Lenawee County Drain Commissioner or to another point found necessary for improvements of such drain is necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare of the Township of Medina.

Tile outlets to be plainly marked in advance of construction.

Existing and functioning connections to tile, as may be found, shall be reconnected.


