PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT *(Note for Defense Attorneys):*

Please refer your client as early as possible in the court process (and before entering a plea) so screening for eligibility may begin. If your client is legally eligible, the Prosecutor's Office may make a plea offer contingent upon successful completion of drug court. *Your client must plead guilty as originally charged. After a plea is entered, you must review the Participant Agreement with your client and bring a signed copy to sentencing and submit it to the drug court.*

The following criteria are reviewed to determine defendant eligibility

<p>Legal Eligibility Requirements <i>(Background check will be conducted.)</i> Defendant's prior record shall not include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Criminal Sexual Conduct (1st, 2nd, or 3rd degree) • Any assaultive felony except Resisting and Obstructing a Police Officer • More than 2 delivery, manufacture, or possession with intent to deliver a controlled substance charges <p>Current charges shall <u>not</u> include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any offense involving death or serious bodily injury to an individual whether or not any of the circumstances are an element of the offense, or an offense that is criminal sexual conduct of any degree. MCL 600.1060(g) • Any assaultive felony except Resisting and Obstructing a Police Officer • Delivery, manufacture, or possession with intent to deliver methamphetamine or heroin 	<p>39th Circuit Court Eligibility Requirements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Age 18 or older • Legal resident of the United States • Resident of Lenawee County • No pending charges in another jurisdiction • Not on probation/parole in another jurisdiction • A link exists between current offense and use of drugs
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<p>Clinical Eligibility Requirements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Qualify for substance use treatment at the level Outpatient Treatment, or higher. • No health conditions that require continuous management with medical marijuana, opiate, or other narcotic medications. • No mental illness requiring the long-term prescription of medication with addictive properties. • No severe and persistent mental health diagnosis or significant cognitive impairment.
