Engineered flood pond for natural habitat was designed in cooperation with the DNR and various wild life organizations.

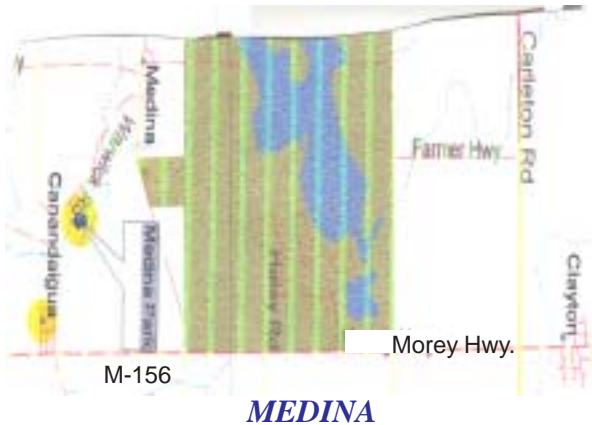
